COVID-19 Testing At Your School



- DCHD has rapid antigen testing kits available, if you'd like to pursue becoming a testing site:
 - Your school will need to be certified to perform antigen test:
 - Obtain a CLIA waiver.
 - Complete self-training for conducting the test.
 - Your school will need to report test results to the health department.
 - Become a user in the UDOH Reporting Portal.
 - Report all test results regularly.

COVID-19 Testing

- Students and Teachers are welcome to utilize the testing sites conducted by UDOH at the Freeport Center, Bldg. C-5 in Clearfield.
- Free testing, symptomatic or testing on day 7 to return to school early.

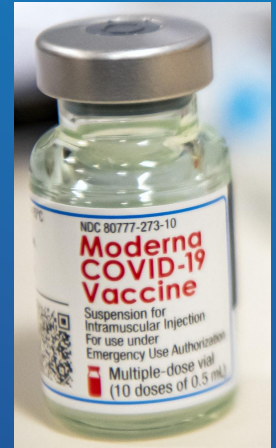

COVID-19 Vaccines

- Staff should start to see a follow-up email to schedule their second dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine.
- Please remind staff to bring their COVID-19 vaccine card and some form of ID to their appointment.
- Pfizer is 21 days apart
- Moderna is 28 days apart

Exposures to Covid-19 with Vaccine

Have not been vaccinated yet:

You must follow the guidelines of low-risk exposure or quarantine.

Had one dose of Covid-19 vaccine:

You must follow the guidelines of low-risk exposure or quarantine.

If you have had BOTH doses of the Vaccine

If it has **NOT** been two weeks since you were vaccinated:

You must follow the guidelines of low-risk exposure or quarantine.

If it has been at least two weeks since you were vaccinated:

You are not required to quarantine.

Symptoms of Covid-19 with Vaccine

Have not been vaccinated yet:
Isolated and get tested right away

Had one dose of Covid-19 vaccine:
Isolated and get tested right away

If you have had BOTH doses of the Vaccine

If it has NOT been two weeks
since you were vaccinated:
Isolated and get tested right away

If it has been at least two weeks
since you were vaccinated:
Isolate and call your doctor or
healthcare provider. It is likely that
something other than COVID-19 is
causing your symptoms.

Reminders:

1. As a reminder, anyone in quarantine due to a household exposure must quarantine the full 10 days and the testing option on day 7 is not available.
2. Remember to use the Referral Certificate - It is attached to the quarantine letter in your letter folder.
3. Anyone who has a community exposure, whether mask-to-mask or not, can return on day 7 with a negative test and no symptoms. (Can use the freeport center)
4. Line list for low-risk exposures. Columns; A, B, D, R & T
5. Vaccine information from slides and more has been added to your google folder as a PDF.
